What is the Advocacy for Innocent Victims Project?

Advocacy for Innocent Victims aims to support innocent victims and survivors of terrorism and 'other Troubles related criminal violence' (in the Northern Ireland context) with an advocacy related issue, particularly but not exclusively related to their justice, truth and accountability needs.
