

SEFF's Accessibility Statement

SEFF's core constituency of benefit are victims/survivors of 'The Troubles,' our membership and users come from right across Section 75 groups and our Staff and sessional providers also come from diverse backgrounds. The one area where we are seeking to make advancement is the composition of our Management Board; we require to increase the numbers of female members and also younger people. Within the last few months, we have begun to address this and have appointed a 30-year-old onto this structure, this will be followed by further appointments over the coming months.

We are acutely aware of issues of disability and work proactively in removing barriers for wheelchair users, those with sight and hearing impairments and indeed through our Health and Wellbeing Casework team we have managed to secure support enhancing equipment transforming the lives of those impacted.

Yearly we review our performance against inclusion issues and in recent years we have further developed as an organisation, providing a strong community outreach role in support of the wider community, this has saw us involving ethnic minority communities, people with disability and without, those from a range of sexual orientation backgrounds, caring responsibilities or otherwise and various version of 'family' (e.g. single parents, adopted or fostering relationships as well as the nuclear family)
